



In Kershaw County 8,000 people experience food insecurity. Living in poverty are 2 out 5 senior adults and 1 out 6 children. Friendship works with other churches in our county to feed the those in need, right where they live. We do this in two ways; Sacks of Love and Love Serve Give.

Sacks of Love

The program is designed to meet the needs of hungry children in Kershaw County School District at times when other resources are not available. This is done by providing them with easy to prepare foods to take home during the weekends or holiday vacations. This will be Friendship's third summer of delivering the sacks to them at home during the break. Principals, guidance counselors, nurses, and teachers identify students who have little or no food to eat when the students are not in school.

All items must be single servings. Canned items should have pop tops for opening. Other items should be tear open or peel off tops.
